

STORYTELLING CHECK LIST FOR LANGUAGE ARTS STANDARDS

Listening to a story or stories, retelling a story told by others, finding or creating an individual or group story, and discussing storytelling with classmates, provide students with opportunities to meet the following language arts standards:

- 1) Share a story with a beginning, middle and end.
- 2) Use sensory details when telling a story.
- 3) Include a sequence of events in a brief story.
- 4) Become a character through the use of voice, posture and attitude.
- 5) Use description to convey character, place and/or situation.
- 6) Retell or adapt a story from different points of view.
- 7) Explore a folktale or fairy tale to discover cultural or historical information.
- 8) Connect the lesson in a story to real life experiences.
- 9) Discuss and understand how problems are solved in a story.
- 10) Understand the difference between fact and fiction.
- 11) Describe chronological, sequential and logical order.
- 12) Discuss how stories reveal cultural similarities and differences.
